

**Message: That your Joy may be full**

**Texts: Matthew 7 verse 7**

**Bible Reading: Luke 18 verse 1- 8**

In John 16 verse 24, the Bible says Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name, ask and ye shall receive that your joy may be full. There are different kinds of Joy, a joy that last only a moment, a joy that is forever, Jesus spoke that you should ask so that your joy may be full, for you to have fullness of Joy, the joy that sorrow cannot over shadow, the joy that last a life time, you must ask, to ask is to make known your request unto God, to ask is to believe that you shall receive, to ask is to be persistent, is praying till you get answers

In Luke 18 from verse 1- 8, Jesus told a parable of a widow, and encouraged us to be like that, she wanted justice against her adversary, she kept asking till she got answers, but in verse 8, the Bible know says when the son of man shall come will he find faith on earth again?

The consequences of not asking?

- In complete deliverance
- Toiled around like waves
- Believe lies
- Anger
- See God as not capable
- Death (physical and spiritual)
